Calibration of Curricular Load for Sec 2 by Offering Subjects at MDL.

Students who offer/will offer at least 3 subjects at MDL in Sec 2 and fulfil the academic requirement may be allowed to offer additional subjects at MDL based on school's holistic assessment of student's ability to cope with the higher academic demands, and if the resulting subject combination would provide student with more options for post-secondary pathways.

These students should satisfy all of the following:

- i. EL, MA and SCI: For at least 2 of these subjects, students should qualify to offer them at MDL the following year (i.e. obtain at least 75%) or already offer at MDL and obtain at least 50% and
- ii. Other subjects which school plan to allow students to offer at MDL: Students can obtain at least 60% for the remaining subjects to be offered ay MDL.

End of Sec 2 -----

Students need to meet the common academic requirement to offer subjects at the same subject levels the following year**.

Academic requirement:

Pass (a) EL and 2 subjects, or

(b) At least half the total number of examinable subjects offered

Students can adjust their curricular load the following year, based on school's holistic considerations which include students' subject-specific performance and their ability to cope with all subjects.
